## ZF Giving in 2010

**HAVERN CENTER: \$25,000**  
(ZF total donations to Havern \$80,000)  
The funds donated to Havern in 2010 were used in the following ways:

- » **\$10,000 for Tuition Assistance Fund:**  
30% of the student body at Havern is in need of scholarship funds. Tuition at Havern per student is \$16,500.
- » **\$10,000 Technology Department**
- » **\$5,000 Continuing Education for Staff**

**LEARNING CAMP: \$15,000**  
(ZF total donations to Learning Camp \$25,000)  
The \$15,000 donation to the Learning Camp™ will be used for scholarships for learning disabled students to attend

summer camp. The Learning Camp™ is one of the first summer camps developed specifically for kids with learning disabilities such as ADD, ADHD, dyslexia and other LD challenges. The \$10,000 donation made in 2008 provided scholarships for 12 children to attend camp.

(ZF total donations to Regis University Scholarship \$90,500)
